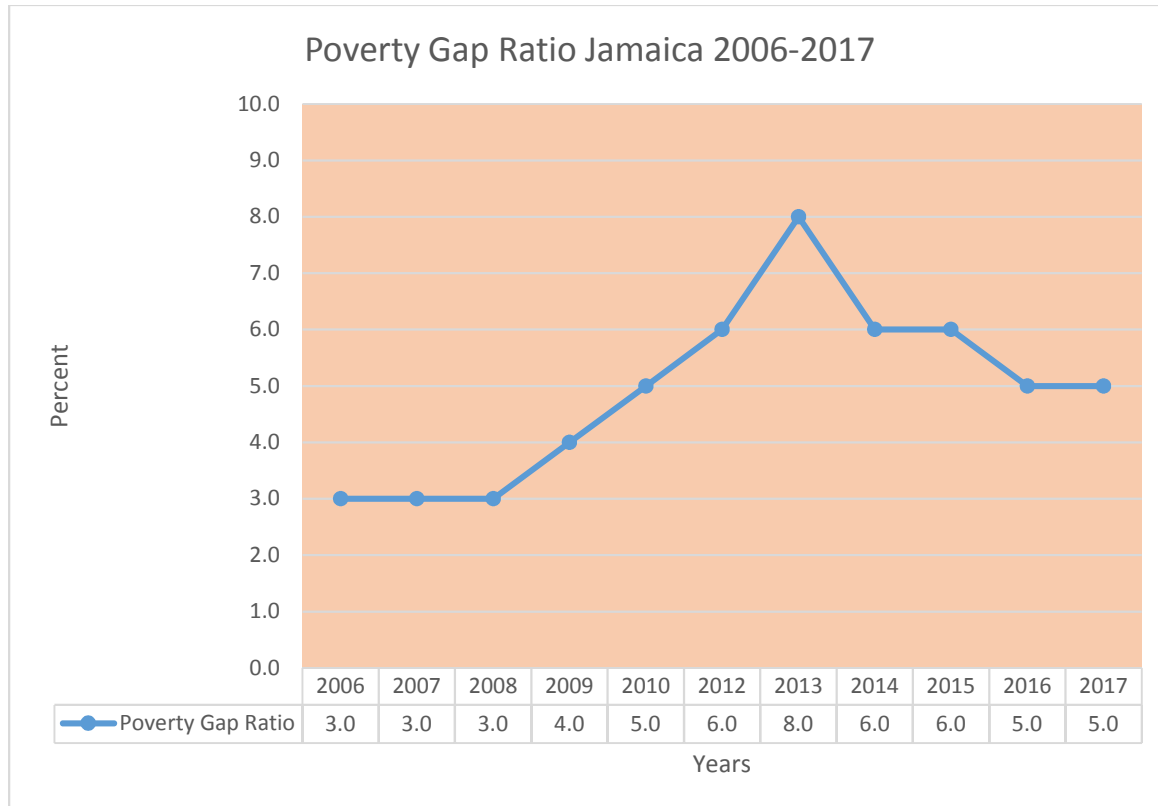


Jamaica, Poverty Gap Ratio 2006 - 2017

The Poverty Gap Ratio is a measure of the average poverty gap in the population expressed as a proportion of the poverty line.

The poverty gap ratio in Jamaica shows an upward trend for the period 2006 – 2017. For the period 2008 to 2013 the trend increases steadily peaking in 2013 at 8.0 percent, but thereafter the trend is generally downward albeit in a cyclic manner.
